PYGMALION broke sharply to take the lead soon after leaving the starting gate, showed the way while facing only mild resistance during the opening half, still held a comfortable advantage upon reaching the eighth pole, then dug in with determination for the decision. TRUST NOBODY raced three wide, rallied in earnest when set down after turning for home, loomed boldly with seventy yards remaining, but didn't have enough to go by. ESTIMATOR chased the winner while wide throughout and held well to the end. BRECCIATE had a good finish outside. NEW YORK STYLE tracked the leader while taking the inside route, had no offering in the stretch. RUN WARRIOR RUN broke awkwardly and failed to reach a contending position. VALID THREAT failed to menace. PAPA JERRY broke poorly after throwing his head at the start, and was outrun thereafter.
