BE BULLISH stalked the pacesetter while travelling in the three path, responded well when asked after entering the stretch, sped past the leader to take control by midstretch, then maintained a safe margin while being kept busy. DISCREET TREASURE outrun for a half while racing along the outside, finished with good energy during the stretch drive to grab place honors. CLOSE TO THE VEST pressed the pace between rivals and weakened during the final eighth. GOLDEN AGE had a three wide journey and failed to make an impact. CLAY COUNTY steadied nearing the turn, was taken outward after entering that bend, remained unhurried until the top of the stretch, was set down but lacked a strong bid. TIZBIG firmly rated along the inside, slipped outward midway on the turn, remained on hold until turning for home, was asked for a response but came up empty. DEVIL'S CONCIERGE within striking distance along the outside, tired. NEW MEMBER showed the way under pressure from a pair of rivals until upper stretch, folded.
