WILD CONGA cut the fractions towards the inside while placed under rating tactics, was asked for a response upon reaching the three-sixteenths pole, dug in stubbornly when the runner up made his presence midstretch, engaged in a head to head duel with that rival from that point and prevailed in a tight photo. FRENCHONIONSOUF reserved within striking distance, began to advance forward when put to encouragement approaching the top of the stretch, drew alongside the leader at the furlong marker, got hooked up in a spirited tussle and came up just short in a good try. GALAN FETE (ARG) was no match for the top pair during the stretch drive. COUNTRY TRICK was no threat. JED GREELEY saved ground and tired. LIGHT FEVER firmly rated stalking the leader during the initial half, came up empty when called upon in the lane. DRIVEN BY ROYAL was no factor. MEL'S GOLD failed to contend. FORTY THIRD RECON was outrun. SAN NAA displayed brief foot, then was eased in the lane.
