SEPTEMBER HERO was outrun early, rallied five wide on the turn and drew clear late under a drive. MUSTANG RANCH was outrun early, rallied inside into the stretch and finished gamely. PERFECT TAKE contested the pace while three wide and weakened in the final furlong. CANNONBALL ROCK raced close up early, rallied four wide nearing the stretch, was steadied turning for home and faded. STRIKE A STAR chased the pace while three wide and tired in the final furlong. TO THE REPUBLIC had no rally. ROSS TO DUBLIN was bumped at the start, dropped back early and had no rally. HIPPIY HIPPIY RED chased the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. ASHLEIGH RIEHL chased the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch. GUIDANCE UP raced wide and tired. SEVEN SEVEN ADAM stumbled at the start, was bumped and tired. LONG SINCE PAST was finished early.
