Footnotes

NORMANDY INVASION tracked inside towards the rear, progressed on the front through the turn coming under a ride at the five-sixteenths, swung four wide in upper stretch seizing command among five stacked across the track at that station, edged well clear under a drive to prevail. TIZ CHRIS broke in at the start, was three to four wide in close pursuit of the leader, came under a drive at the three-eighths pole, was three wide at the quarter pole with a pair on each side stacked across, proved unable to match strides with the top one through the lane while keeping on mildly, weakened in the late stages and just held for the place honors. MARKET BLASTER was away awkwardly, tracked just off the inside from just off the pace, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, swung three wide at the quarter pole in behind a wall of rivals, offered up mild late energy and just missed the place honors while safely garnering the show. SAMPSON COUNTY hesitated at the start, chased three wide in mid pack, made a mild bid in the latter portion of the turn into prominence to be stacked five wide in upper stretch, got out kicked through the lane flattening out in the late stages. SNIFTER broke a half beat slow at the start, raced just off the inside towards the rear, was placed to a drive nearing the five-sixteenths, responded a bit erratic and greenly under a drive, offered up a mild kick while making no impact. PICEANCE just off the pace four to five wide, came under a prolonged drive at the seven-sixteenths, improved position after straightening away while making no headway. TIMELESS INDY threw his head at the start, chased two to three wide in close range, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, was among the quintet stacked across in upper stretch in contention for command, tired through the stretch. DETERRENT set the pace inside under some pressure by a pair in close range, got asked nearing the quarter pole as a host of pursuers confronted him stacked four across to his outside, was overwhelmed at that station and faltered in the lane. A. M. MAYHEM chased three to four wide towards the rear, maneuvered to the rail at the seven-sixteenths, came under a drive at the three-eighths pole, retreated and offered no response. FEDERAL AGENT was detached and last early on racing very greenly and trailed.
