FLIRTATIOUS SPRING assumed a forward position soon after the start, rated kindly while prompting the leader from the two path until the end of the backstretch, ranged up and challenged that opponent in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, took over from a much energetically-handled foe to lead the field into the stretch, had the runner up drew on even terms coming to the eighth pole, battled heads apart from that point onward, refused to give up. MADAME JOHAR unhurried during the initial stages from off the inside, launched a four wide run departing the backstretch to reach a good striking position by the head of the stretch, lost none of her momentum, reaching the furlong marker directly outside and eye to eye with the top one, fought gallantly the remainder of the way but got denied by a very determined rival. MELA DRAMATICALLY three wide around both turns, weakened in the final furlong. ARTIE R R saved ground until the end of the backstretch, was three wide late on the far turn, continued to advance in the right direction before flattening out once past the furlong grounds. CORIANDER strung out three wide on the opening bend, remained well off the inside throughout, fanned six wide into the lane and mustered up a mild response to mainly improve position. SILVER D' ORO angled off the inside at the quarter pole, lacked the necessary stretch

response. MARCY faltered off a ground-saving journey. HERMOSURA was always outrun while saving ground until the quarter pole. SWIFT TAYLOR stalked the front runners from the outside and folded. FIELD STAR at least three wide on the first turn, took the overland route around the subsequent one while unleashing a menacing move, couldn't sustain it and gave way. SILVER PRIZE grabbed the advantage and tucked over to the rail, showed the way being rated and under the attention of the eventual winner, came under increased pressure from that one on the far turn, yielded despite being under a drive and retreated. BUNHEAD raced from off the inside and was through after going three-quarters.
