Footnotes

ST LIAMS HALO saved ground in mid pack, cut the corner roused into the stretch, rallied into contention a furlong out, scraped the paint to take over a sixteenth from home edging away at the end to prevail. TINY PREDICAMENT hustled at the start, prompted the pace three wide, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, swung four wide for home, dug in fighting on outside a trio to garner the place honors in the last jumps. LUXURY APPEAL away well, got coaxed along pressing the pace from the inside, was set down in earnest at the head of the stretch, dug in battling to take narrow command a furlong out, was headed near the sixteenth marker and kept on for the show. MR. STYLE cut a pressured pace from just off the inside with foes on both sides, got let out at the quarter pole, clung narrowly to the front until headed a furlong out, dug in to fight on to the sixteenth marker before being outfinished in the late

stages. POLITICAL JUSTICE tracked the pace inside within aim, swung three wide for home set down for the drive, bid mildly on the front but lacked a clear lane between foes, altered out at the eighth pole for clearance and finished evenly late on. CURVE BALL three to four wide in mid pack in range of the front, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, angled six wide into upper stretch, improved position late while unable to make an impact. SAY MR. SANDMAN coaxed along in pursuit just off the inside in mid pack, spun three wide at the quarter pole and made no impact. CLASSIC R AND B three wide towards the rear, came under urging three furlongs from home, angled five to six wide into upper stretch and never threatened. TATAO'S WIDCAT hustled at the start, chased two to three wide just off the pace, came under a ride midway on the turn, angled five wide for home and tired in the stretch. SUPERIORITY just off the inside towards the rear, came under encouragement at the three-eighths, swung three wide at the head of the lane and proved no menace. GAME TOKEN three wide towards the rear, got ridden along from three furlongs out, angled four to five wide for home and offered little.
