DOCTRESSA unhurried while racing along the inside, rallied along the inside on the turn, got through along the rail, getting the nod in the final strides. FAMILY TIME broke awkwardly and was outrun early, launched a four wide rally on the turn, closed gallantly down the outside of the course, narrowly missing. BETSY BLUE EYES was well rated while reserved off the early pacesetter, moved to engage that one approaching the turn, gained a clear advantage by midstretch, weakened in the late stages. SHIKI, unhurried early on, rallied on the rail on the second turn then was shut off while attempting to split rivals in midstretch and was forced to take up. EXPENSIVE COFFEE rallied four wide on the second turn but had little left for the stretch drive. CYNDI'S GLITTER quickly sprinted clear, set the pace into the stretch and gave way. ANOTHER APPROVAL chased three wide and tired. ANGELA'S APPROVAL, rated along inside, bled.
