OH WHAT A WINDFALL raced close up early, gained a short lead while between rivals into the stretch then continued on to hold LA VILLE ROUGE safe for the win. LA VILLE ROUGE raced with the pace from the outside while in hand, was three wide on the turn and finished determinedly from the outside. HONOUR A BULL was urged along inside on the backstretch, was taken wide on the turn, came through along the rail entering the stretch then finished with good courage while angling to the outside in deep stretch. TAP YOUR HEELS stumbled leaving the gate, set the pace while in hand then weakened in the stretch. BLUSHING DEED was rated along early then was roused on the turn but offered nothing. CALL ME UP was rated along outside, raced four wide around the turn and had no response. DELICATE ROSE chased on the rail and tired. CARNY'S CREEK was outrun.
