Footnotes

ANCIENT ROME contested the pace from the outside, made a successful challenge to grab a slight advantage as the field headed into the stretch, dug in well enough and long enough to fend off the late charge coming from WANSTEAD to preserve the decision. WANSTEAD in the three path entering the turn, was in the fourth one exiting it, came home with strong late energy but fell short of reeling in the winner. CYBERTRON sat forwardly placed three wide chasing the contested pace, ranged up during the later stages of the run around the bend and spun into the lane as the widest of the frontrunners, got outfinished. GRAND CONTENDER came in slightly leaving the starting gate, resulting in an exchange of several bumps with BROOKLYN RED, none of which was too severe, rode the rail around the turn, was angled outward for the commencement of the stretch run, lacked the needed response. DEVOTED WILDCAT was hand urged while arguing for control down the backstretch, tucked along the rail coming to the half mile pole, was still being hassled by the top one when the runner up cranked up the pressure a few jumps prior to the quarter pole, succumbed and backed away steadily. PROFESSOR FATE between rivals on the turn, tired. FLYING MASSTER broke inward a couple of steps, necessitating the rider to grab hold and pull away from the nearest opponent at the time to prevent any contact, raced from off the rail, got placed at the head of the stretch, had no discernable rally. BROOKLYN RED got bumped several times in rapid succession at the start, rode the rail for the opening half, angled outward entering the stretch with no offering to render.
