CLASSIC R AND B three wide the closest pursuer of the spurting leader, came under coaxing three furlongs out, seized command from a withering front at the three-sixteenths, widened clear under a drive, came under a vigorous hand ride through the final sixteenth to prevail comfortably. TIZMAS tracked the pace along the inside, came under a drive at the five-sixteenths, got bumped solidly at the three-sixteenths as GOODTIME BOY came in under off sided stick work, got knocked off stride losing some momentum, kicked home mildly for the place while never a threat to the top one. GOODTIME BOY chased the front from mid pack along the inside, got asked at the five-sixteenths, swung four wide for home, came in under off sided stick work at the three-sixteenths bumping TIZMAS soundly knocking that foe off stride, bid mildly through the lane for the show honors. AMBASSADOR BRIDGE just off the inside towards the rear, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, spun three wide into the stretch, kicked home belatedly for the last major share. PEGASUS PAPOU four to five wide towards the rear, came under a drive nearing the five-sixteenths and passed tired rivals in the lane. BACKDOWN hustled from the gate, spurred away lightly coaxed through solid fractions, cut the corner into the stretch shortening stride and losing his advantage, got displaced on the front at the

three-sixteenths and gave way. TONINTHIRTEEN three to four wide towards the rear, got asked at the five-sixteenths, made no impact. GINGER'S JOE three wide mid pack, came under a prolonged drive being pushed along from the seven-sixteenths and offered no response. WHY BROADWAY just off the pace, came under coaxing three furlongs out and tired after a half. SHOUTOUT three wide forwardly placed, was in tight between foes and off heels from the nine-sixteenths to the half mile pole in hand caught in a blind switch, remained in hand to gain some maneuvering room, came under a drive at the three-eighths pole and offered no kick. WARRIOR FROM ABOVE coaxed along inside forwardly placed, steadily retreated through the turn and tired.
