ALL TIED UP came away without incident at the start, patiently kept watch on the front runners from the two path, racing as a team with CLASSIC SENSE, himself down along the rail, picked up interest when asked to with a few strides left on the far turn, swung three wide into the stretch and got called upon for a response, gave it willingly, latching on to the second place finisher with a furlong to go, sparred intensely with that opponent all the while whittling away at the lead, inched his way to the front right near the finish line to prove best. SYCAMORE LANE assumed a forward position shortly after the start, prompted the pacesetter from the two path, had the rider of the nemesis be the first to commit to active handling, this occurring a few jumps before reaching the quarter pole, responded positively when given his cue to shake free for good, felt the winner's presence though by the end of the run through the furlong grounds, fought with vigor but get reeled in. CLASSIC SENSE tracked the front runners while taking the inside route, angled outward near the top of the lane, proved no match. THIS GUY IS BLUE departed the backstretch three wide, improved position, left the five-sixteenths marker under a drive, made no additional headway. ROMANS PARADISE vied for command from the rail, got roused prior to the quarter pole, backed away. STRATEGIC KEEPER was quickly guided over to the inside, cut the corner being urged, made no impact. KID CRUZ between foes on the opening bend, folded. FRANKED saved ground for nearly three-quarters, tired. BLAST AWAY strung out three wide on the first turn, was through by the end of the backstretch.
