Footnotes

COMANDANTE vied just off the inside, took over the front midway on the turn under light coaxing, got set down three wide at the quarter pole, inched away under a drive kept busy to the wire. CRAFTY DREAMER broke a bit awkwardly at the start, settled three wide in mid pack, came under a ride nearing the five-sixteenths, spun four wide for home, offered up a mild kick chasing the winner home second best and clear of the rest. JACK'S R WILD off the inside initially towards the rear, raced three to four wide through the turn coming under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, angled seven wide into upper stretch, offered up mild late energy to secure the show. JUNIOR OFFICER saved ground in mid pack, came under urging and advanced to the quarter pole into contention, fought on to the eighth pole before flattening out in the late stages. ALCOLITE four wide in mid pack, took the overland route through the turn

coming under a ride three furlongs out, angled six wide for home and kept on evenly through the drive. SUMMER PLACE TO BE broke out at the start bumping PETROCELLI, was coaxed along three wide in close aim of the front, got let out at the five-sixteenths and weakened in the stretch. MISTER DOOLEY just off the inside towards the rear, got urged and angled four wide at the three-eighths, spun three wide for home and passed tired foes. CHARLIE'S PUNCH just off the pace in pursuit just off the inside, had to steady briefly at the three-eighths as SATURDAY APPEAL came out slightly at that station, came under urging at the five-sixteenths and tired. SATURDAY APPEAL tracked the pace along the inside in mid pack, came under encouragement at the three-eighths, faded bearing the quarter pole and made no impact. STOPTHEFEVER vied inside on the pace, got headed at the three-eighths pole coming under a ride at the five-sixteenths, cut the corner into the stretch and folded. PETROCELLI bumped at the start when SUMMER PLACE TO BE broke outwards, raced three to four wide in close aim of the front, got ridden along midway on the turn, retreated in the latter portion of the turn to the quarter pole and tired.
