SEXUAL HARRASMENT contested the pace while between rivals and dug in gamely to earn the place prize. DRAWING A BLANK contested the pace while three wide and weakened in deep stretch. TWIST AND POP contested the pace along the inside and tired in the final furlong. CARNIE'S DANCER raced close up early and lacked a rally. PAUGUS BAY was outrun early, raced inside and had no rally. KARAKORUM CRUSADER raced wide and tired. MOLOKO tired.
