SILVER WAGON was outrun early, advanced three wide on the turn, ran by pacesetter AFRASHAD nearing the eighth pole, quickly drew away and was kept busy to the finish. SIR GREELEY stumbled badly at the start, dropped far back early, came wide into the stretch and finished gamely outside. AFRASHAD quickly showed in front, set the pace along the inside, drew clear into the stretch and tired in the final furlong. KAZOO pressed the pace from the outside and tired in the final furlong. P. KERNEY bobbled at the start, was hustled outside, chased the pace for a half mile and tired. BISHOP COURT HILL chased the pace along the inside and tired. BLAZING PURRSUIT stumbled badly at the start, unseating his rider. Following a general Stewards' inquiry the result was declared official.
