SOLAR FLARE (ARG) firmly rated three wide, advanced forward when ready after entering the stretch, grabbed the lead just past the eighth pole, then maintained a safe margin under intermittent urging to the wire. MORE THAN A REASON rode the rail during the initial stages, came outward midway around the turn, gained readily on his own courage after reaching the stretch, maintained his momentum after being put to encouragement with a furlong remaining and finished with good courage to take place honors. TIMBER RESERVE pressed the pace from the two path, was outfinished during the stretch drive. GOLD TRIPPI was sluggish during the opening half after being squeezed back a bit at the start, outkicked mainly weak rivals during the stretch run while never posing a real threat. MT. GLITTERMORE saved ground and faltered after going three-quarters. EDDIE C. rated between rivals until the quarter pole, steadily tired thereafter. DA' TARA cut the pace along the rail into upper stretch and folded.
