PREMIUM WINE sat well placed from off the inside, just off the ongoing pace fight, was taken in hand coming to the five-sixteenths pole, picked up speed angling outward at that station, out raced the IRON LOU to the four path coming to the quarter pole, forcing the rider of that opponent to steady, out kicked the front runners to take charge during the ensuing furlong, edged away and remained in front under good handling to the end. IRON LOU three wide departing the backstretch, was put to an early drive, lost position to the top one when unable to keep pace approaching the quarter pole, got steadied, now placed just off that rival's heels heading into upper stretch, got going again soon afterwards and finished with good courage. DEVONSHIRE launched a rail rally for the show. ORSONIAN took the overland route, was put to some encouragement from the vicinity of the half mile pole, held his ground well before flattening out a bit in the late stages. ANEW argued for control from the inside with another twosome, faltered. WELCHTOWN disputed the pace between rivals for half before backing away. HE'S A SCROOGE saved ground and failed to menace. BROTHER IN ARMS was the widest off three contesting the pace for a half, tired. POPPA'S PICK was outrun. Following a Stewards' Inquiry, as well a claim of foul lodged by the rider of IRON LOU against the rider of PREMIUM WINE, the latter was disqualified from first and placed second for causing interference at the top of the stretch.
