Footnotes

I'LL TAKE NOTES chased the leader while taking the inside route, steadily advanced towards that opponent, made a successful challenge to take away the lead prior to turning into the stretch, got called upon and kicked well clear during the ensuing furlong, fended off the runner up leaving the eighth pole, kept to a hard drive to the end. GRAND MERE sat a loose pocket for the opening half, began to pick up interest leaving the five-sixteenths pole, angled outward entering the stretch, made little progress on the top one from upper to midstretch, cut the margin thereafter en route to be second best. YOUNGWILDANDFREE chased from off the inside and was outfinished. PASSIONFORSONGS broke outward slightly, was put back on a truer course after the second of two yanks on the left rein by the pilot, set the pace from the two path on the turn, with the rider applying some pressure once more on the left rein for much of the run around the bend, got set down but surrendered the front nonetheless arriving at the quarter pole, fell back readily once into the lane. PRINCESSBELLAONCAL raced along the outside, was under solid urging swinging four wide to the three-sixteenths pole, had no rally. LADY JARLYN taken over to the rail at the half mile pole, failed to have any impact despite being put to a drive. JOANNE'S HALO underwent a three wide pursuit, folded.
