TWO ITEM LIMIT was never far back in the early going, advanced inside on the turn, angled out in upper stretch, responded when roused and drew clear under a drive. CELTIC MELODY broke awkwardly, hitting the gate at the start, showed good speed along the inside while in hand, argued the pace and stayed on gamely on the rail. TWINING STAR argued the pace while between rivals and tired in the stretch. ERIN MOOR raced inside and had no rally. SALTY YOU stumbled at the start, raced with the pace while four wide and tired in the stretch. TRIAL FIGHTER was hustled along outside, raced with the pace while three wide and tired after three quarters.
