PLAY IT TRUE flashed good speed from the outside, contested the pace, drew clear when roused and reported home promptly under a drive. STORMY WINTER was outrun early, altered course when in traffic in the stretch and finished well outside. SOBE'S CHOICE raced close up along the inside, came wide into the stretch and offered a mild rally outside. DARJEELING was outrun early, angled out in the stretch and was going well late. CABBAGE PATCH GAL was urged along outside, put in a four wide run on the turn and faded in the stretch. MARIETTA was steadied after the start, raced five wide and tired in the final furlong. EVA MARIA contested the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch. DR. D'S ARCHANGEL tired after a half. CLASSIC NEEL raced six wide and tired. TIZZY'S JAZZ had no rally. AMAZI was finished early. LIPPETY SPLIT had no response when roused.
