FOR FILLIES TWO YEARS OLD ELIGIBLE FOR THE NEW YORK STALLION STAKES. By subscription of \$100 due on or before December 1, 2004, with the following eligibility payments; \$100 due on or before November 1, 2005; \$250 due on or before March 1, 2006; \$350 due on or before June 1, 2006; \$500 to pass the entry box, \$500 to start. All monies to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. 5% of purses won to be awarded to the stallion nominator. 122 lbs. LAURENTIDE ICE was outrun early, came wide for the drive, dug in resolutely outside and prevailed after a hard drive. TWISTAWAY was hustled along early, chased the pace from the outside and dug in gamely to the finish. ALL FIRED UP pressed the pace from the outside and weakened in the final furlong. NORDBERG stumbled badly at the start, was bumped then raced inside and lacked a rally. CROSSTOWN TRAFFIC quickly showed in front, set the pace into the stretch and tired. SWEET VICTORY had no response when roused. PRECIOUS TOO was bumped at the start, bore out on the turn and tired.
