**Footnotes**

SPY IN THE SKY well rated until the quarter pole, was fanned four wide into the lane, rallied in earnest once straightened away, took command at the sixteenth pole and edged away, driving. BLAZING DYNAMO reserved for over a mile, was swung three wide into the stretch and came home with good energy to grab the place. HANGINGBYATHREAD unhurried racing along the outside, advanced into contention three wide around the final turn, was outfinished by the top pair during the final eighth. BIG AL took the inside route behind the runaway leader, came outward approaching the third turn, readily moved towards the leader, gained the lead as the field headed for the stretch, left the furlong grounds with a clear advantage, before weakening steadily thereafter. JANE'S KID outfinished mainly weak rivals during the stretch drive. SOLVENT lacked a solid closing kick after being called upon at the quarter pole. WESTERN INFLUENCE moved to a good striking position during the run around the final bend, was forced to steady behind rivals approaching the head of the stretch, angled outward for clearance at the three-sixteenths pole, came up empty when asked for a response. CHAPIN BEACH made a three wide run in hand to establish command, was taken inward nearing the second turn, sped off to a long lead, continued to show the way, relinquished when challenged turning for home and steadily tired thereafter. PIAZZA DI SPAGNA saved ground throughout.
