TIZ CLEAR forwardly placed between rivals during the initial stages, was taken hold and successfully eased back into midpack, gave chase from the two path, entered the stretch and was put to strong left handed stick work, altered course to be outside the two front runners nearing the eighth pole, picked up speed after completing the maneuver, forged on ahead, collaring LAUNCH N RELAUNCH in the final strides to prove best. LAUNCH N RELAUNCH refused to rate kindly despite being put to a firm hold, eagerly moved up to assume a forward post, was guided over to the inside once sufficiently clear, argued for control with another twosome for the remainder of the opening half, got put to a drive turning for home, put away the challenge coming from HAMMERSMITH during the ensuing furlong, displayed good determination as the top one narrowed in before yielding reluctantly. HAMMERSMITH got bumped at the start, started four wide at the beginning of the bend to reach a good striking position by the quarter pole, was heavily roused putting the runner up to the test as that pair entered the lane, got turned back shortly before arriving at the eighth pole, weakened steadily into the show slot thereafter. CELLA MUFFLER bounced between opponents at the break darted over to the rail, raced sluggishly proceeding towards the half mile pole, stayed along the inside route and was already under encouragement cutting the corner into the lane, rallied mildly to improve position. PAVLOV'S DOG three wide departing the backstretch, lacked the necessary stretch response. SARATOGA SQUIER was bumped at the start, was coaxed along pressing the issue the widest of a threesome for about a half, folded. CONTROVERSIAL displayed early foot along the inside, was under a full drive by the five-sixteenths pole, tired. IT'S THE BIG CAT contested the pace between rivals, tired, and returned bleeding.
