**Footnotes**

BROOKLYN RED left the backstretch four wide, ranged up from well off the inside during the run around the bend, struck the front under his own courage as the field headed for the top of the lane, held a slim advantage nearing the eighth pole, swerved outward suddenly several paths while reacting greenly to the third of three left handed shots from the whip, fell back slightly, settled back into stride in short order to take charge again and drew away. DOWN BROADWAY started the run around the bend from the three path, was put to a drive from the five-sixteenths pole, entered the stretch slightly behind and with more than one path separating the top twosome, inherited the lead as the winner went through his antics with about an eighth to go, proved no match once that rival got going well, but continued on willingly to secure second. DISCREET CODE rallied mildly for third. SHERIDAN SQUARE made a brief run to improve position during the initial portion of the stretch drive before flattening out. BLAKE STREET BULLY hustled early, settled into midpack, saved ground on the turn, was under a drive cutting the corner into the lane, lacked the needed response. MAD BOMBER lagged behind the opening half while riding the rail, was angled outward in upper stretch, flashed good belated energy en route to out finishing weak and tired ones. FUZZY DUNLOP between rivals for a good portion of the way around the turn, had no rally. EXCITING MISSILE failed to menace. DAN'S GOLD argued for control from the inside, was set down by the five-sixteenths pole, faltered. HAVING A NICE TIME underwent a three wide pursuit, folded. HEPATOLOGIST was taken hold after bobbling at the start, contested the pace as a forward factor for nearly a half, then tired.
