SCATMANDU, bumped at the start and in hand early on, advanced three wide on the turn, reached the front in upper stretch then dug in gamely and held off ARISTOTLE for the win. ARISTOTLE, bumped at the start and four wide throughout, finished gamely from the outside. WATCHMAN'S WARNING, bumped at the start and outrun early, was going well late. POWER BY FAR, ducked out at the start, bumping WATCHMAN'S WARNING, then chased the pace and continued on gamely to the finish. SAY FLORIDA SANDY, roughed up between rivals at the start, raced three wide and was steadied from between rivals on the turn. BOUGHT IN DIXIE, outrun early, raced inside and had no rally. PUNCHER stumbled badly at the start, ducked out after the start, ran off to a long lead on the backstretch and tired in the stretch. SAILOR'S WARNING chased the pace along the rail and tired in the stretch.
