BONEFIDE REASON was outrun early, raced inside and finished well. LIGHTS ON raced close up while three wide and had no response when roused. SILK CONCORDE chased the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch. A. P. ANDIE had no rally. GOLDEN MADE contested the pace along the inside and tired.
