SHORTY KNUDTSON was roughed up between rivals at the start, was outrun early, swung wide entering the stretch, finished strongly outside and drew away late. JIM'S SMOKIN PINOT contested the pace while three wide and continued on to earn the place prize. PENNANT CONTENDER raced greenly early on, was inside on the turn and finished well. INDESTRUCTIBLE raced in hand while three wide and finished well outside. ROYAL SULTAN raced close up inside and offered a mild stretch rally. HIGH OCTANE chased the pace from the outside and tired. BLUE CRANE was bumped at the start, raced inside and had no rally. STORMIN J. P. was bumped at the start, contested the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. WOODLANDER contested the pace while between rivals and tired in the stretch. RATIONALEXUBERANCE raced close up inside, angled out in the stretch and had no response when roused.
