MAYFIELD stumbled badly at the start, was outrun early, rallied five wide on the turn and drew away late. LASIK chased the pace while four wide and finished gamely to get the place spot. HIGH PEAKS contested the pace while between rivals, drew clear in the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. COME DANCE contested the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch. KENT HALL had no rally. AWESOMENESS had no response when roused. GEORGETOWN GAL was outrun along the inside. FLY WITH KARAKORUM showed speed along the inside and was finished early.
