SEVENTH STREET reserved four wide, was set down at the three-sixteenths pole, took over in short order and drew off while remaining under encouragement. FLYING DIXIE vied for the lead between rivals, proved no match for the top one during the stretch drive, but finished well to secure the place. KEWLAND outrun early, was stacked six wide at the top of the stretch, and had a good finish outside. MAGNIFICENT LADY had a three wide trip and was no factor. AMERICAN QUEEN battled for the lead three wide and gave way after entering the lane. TOUCH TOO MUCH raced along the outside and lacked a rally. COURTING ELAINE urged early, failed to gain ground. VALID HUMOR a pace factor along the rail, was through after going three furlongs. L. C. CHOPARD trailed.
