FULL MOON BLUES established control soon the start when TAP FOR LUCK backed off during the opening stages, set moderate early fractions, well rated in the two path, and without facing any real resistance, approached the head of the stretch, still firmly in charge, spurted away from the competition when set down in upper stretch, emerged from the furlong grounds with her biggest advantage and held safely while being kept busy to the end. TAP FOR LUCK broke running, was placed under a snug hold and taken back, continued to bide time down the backstretch, under a firm hold, entered the turn from the four path, narrowed in a bit during the run around the bend, swung three wide into the lane while now being asked for run, came outward in midstretch, taking the eventual show horse along for the ride, got put on a truer course by the sixteenth pole, then finished with a good belated kick to garner the place. DIXIE CITY sat reserved towards the back of the pack for nearly three-quarters, commenced to rally while fanning three wide into the lane, was carried out several paths during the middle portion of the stretch drive by the runner up, continued onward with good courage to take the show. PINCH PIE well placed tracking the leader from the inside, came up empty when called upon in the stretch. DOING GREAT rated prompting the leader from the outside, backed off after going six furlongs.
