TO HONOR AND SERVE away in good order, made the front under his own courage, cut the fractions towards the inside, on a loosely-contested lead and being rated along, entered the stretch with a comfortable advantage, was briefly hand urged from past the three-sixteenths pole to the furlong marker, had the rider take one long back at the field, then was allowed to coast home under the mildest of hand rides. MUCHO MACHO MAN tracked the leader from the inside, but was no match turning for home. QUALITY COUNCIL rated stalking the leader from the outside, was outkicked. SETTLE FOR MEDAL off the inside, was put to a prolonged drive but had no impact throughout. ECONOMIC SUMMIT raced three wide around the turn and tired.
