A HANDICAP FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. No nomination fee. A supplemental nomination fee of \$2,000 may be made on or before Sunday, October 31. \$1,500 to pass the entry box. All starters including supplements are required to pay the starting fee and will receive a \$1,000 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, October 23, 2010 with 33 Nominations. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at One Mile and One Quarter on the Main Track.)

GRASSY judiciously took the inside route around the first two turns, found ample opportunity to be maneuvered off the inside after departing the second of three turns, bided his time, began to pick up the pace, gearing up for the stretch drive, swung four wide into the homestretch, took off with an impressive acceleration of speed once called upon, surged by to take charge and edged clear under good handling. RESCUE SQUAD found refuge along the inside entering the stretch the first time, saved ground before slipping out in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, turned for home, still well in hand, was asked for a response near the three-sixteenths pole, rallied willingly between rivals to garner place honors. BOLD HAWK rated in the three path around the opening bend, was a bit closer to the inside for the run around the next one, chose the three path for the third turn, ranged up nearing the quarter pole, narrowed in during the ensuing furlong but was outkicked thereafter. WHATSTHESCRIP (IRE) led the field around the first turn, well in hand, gave up the front during the straightaway approach to the second turn, content to track the new leader, was taken out outward leaving the backstretch, moved up to challenge for the lead at the three-eighths pole, edged away to a clear advantage with an eighth to go, but failed to sustain the momentum. SIMMARD forwardly placed and well in hand until the quarter pole, lacked the necessary stretch response. STRIKE A DEAL worked his way to the lead in time for the run around the second bend, showed the way under a firm hold, was put to the test at the three-eighths pole and succumbed. JEUNE-TURC (BRZ) rank early fighting the bit, trailed for over a mile, made a mild bid along the inside turning for home, but soon flattened out.
