SUMMER FRONT brushed with SPORTWRITER at the start, settled into midpack from off the inside, remained unhurried until reaching the far turn, was maneuvered into the three path at the five-sixteenths pole, spun into the stretch one path wider and commenced to rally, grabbed the lead and kicked clear of a tightly-packed group a slight distance behind arriving at the furlong marker, was put to confident hand encouragement departing that station, had the rider sneak a quick peak back with about a sixteenth to go, saw the margin dangerously cut into by the second place finisher, got switched to an intermittent left handed whip to fend off that opponent. LIQUIDITY TRAP unhurried for nearly three-quarters, swung five wide, to be widest of all into the stretch, closed the gap from the winner readily throughout leaving the furlong grounds, but had to settle for being clearly second best. CAPTAIN WEBB got lightly bumped by an errant RICHMOND COUNTY at the start, assumed a forward position and stalked the front runner, was let out a notch at the three-eighths pole continuing along on that mission, got set down for the stretch drive and out finished. STATE FLAG brushed at the start, took the inside route and lacked the necessary stretch response. WESTERN TRYST chased the pacesetter from near the two path, hesitated as that rival came inward in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, came up empty after that brief incidence. RICHMOND COUNTY came inward, bobbling after bouncing off of CAPTAIN WEBB, went on willingly to grab the front, cut the pace while racing along the inside, felt intensified pressure late on the second turn, soon succumbed to it, remained a prominent factor until midstretch before backing away. SPORTSWRITER reared up after the field was loaded in, flicking off the rider in the result, was backed out, had the pilot remount and was reloaded, made light contact with the top one at the start, prompted the pacesetter from the outside, under a firm hold during the initial stages, kept pace for three-quarters and tired. HE'S A FIREBALL squeezed back at the start, trailed throughout.
