Weight: 122 lbs.: Non-winners of a Sweepstakes at a mile or over on the turf since June 1 allowed 2 lbs.; three races, 4 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, starter and restricted allowance races not considered). A presentation will be made to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, October 22, 2011, with 19 Nominations. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at One Mile on the Main Track.).

**Footnotes**

MASTER SHADE (ITY) was rated kindly in the two path for the opening three-quarters, responded positively when given his cue in the stretch, took over in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole and edged away, being hand urged to the end. MY REDBYRD well reserved until the head of the stretch, accelerated with good energy coming to the furlong marker, continued on willingly in the last eighth to secure second. GOOD KARMA (ITY) was put to a firm hold while establishing control soon after the start, remained well rated while showing the way near the inside for the initial six furlongs, began to drift outward slightly at the five-sixteenths pole, with PUZZLING shadowing that one to the outside, briefly surrendered the front as NAPLES BAY scampered along the unsecured rail to grab the lead, fought back well, with PUZZLED still pressing hard directly to the outside, to regain the lead, held it until the near the sixteenth pole, then weakened. ARCH SUPPORT off a beat slowly, raced three wide around both turns, displayed a mild kick for the last major award. PUZZLING underwent a three wide journey, bid for command approaching the quarter pole, got carried out slightly entering the stretch, kept up the pressure before weakening in the final sixteenth. MOUNT HOLIDAY saved ground and failed to be a factor. DECENNIAL saved ground to no avail. NAPLES BAY tracked the front runners from the inside, was let out a notch departing the backstretch, steadily advanced in the right direction during the run around the bend, eagerly launched a quick move, availing of a clear passageway along the rail, coming to the quarter pole, struck the front grabbing a narrow lead, but held it only momentarily, backed away readily after yielding it. FIRE ASSAY prompted the leader from the outside for almost six furlongs, folded.
