MANAGED ACCOUNT stalked the leader, was asked for some run coming to the five-sixteenths pole, made little progress during the initial portion of the stretch drive, angled outward with a furlong remaining, began to pick up ground more readily, successfully wore down LAUNCH COMMANDER in the final strides to prevail. LAUNCH COMMANDER vied for the lead from the inside, shook free soon after the half mile pole, still held a comfortable advantage with an eighth to go, got collared late. NIGHT MANEUVER took up position from the three path off the early duel, came up empty. HANNIBAL LECTER bumped after the start, was through after completing three-quarters. JACK'S IN THE DECK three to four wide on the turn, tired. POLLARD'S BOY took the overland route on the turn to no avail. WON THE WAR ducked inward shortly after leaving the gate, making contact with HANNIBAL LECTER as a result, moved up to contest the pace from the two path, kept up that pursuit for almost six furlongs before fading.
