STORMIN FEVER, bumped at the start but close up inside under wraps, was steered between rivals in the stretch, reached the front inside the eighth pole and quickly drew away after one right-handed smack from the whip. OLYMPIC CAT, bumped at the start, contested the pace from the outside and continued gamely through the stretch. ADVERSE flashed good speed from the gate, contested the pace along the inside and gave ground grudgingly through the stretch. SAY FLORIDA SANDY, between rivals early, came wide for the drive and finished well. LIBERTY GOLD, never far back, put in a four wide run approaching the stretch but could not sustain that bid. HOLZMEISTER, bumped at the start and outrun early, raced inside and had no rally. HIT THE ROOF raced with the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch. FENTON LANE, bumped at the start, raced wide and had no response. GRAY RAIDER raced wide and tired badly.
