BRASSY SHIRLEY chased the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch. GALLOPING TO TEA raced wide and had no rally. FOREVER FLAWLESS raced inside and had no response when roused. GINGER'S JET tired after a half mile. CHEQUE THE GREEN had no rally. EYE STOPPER chased inside and tired. MARNIE'S HEIRLOOM broke slowly and was outrun.
