BANK THE EIGHT broke on top but dropped back after stumbling a few strides out of the gate, advanced forward without need of encouragement to improve his position, was taken out to the five path turning for home, rallied in earnest when set down, gained readily to loom seriously approaching the sixteenth pole, went by the leader to take charge and held sway under a drive. ARGENTARII unhurried for over a half, was fanned five wide into the lane and came home willingly. WORLD RECORD kept off the inside, was forced to steady when caught in traffic near the eighth pole, eventually gained the necessary clearance and displayed a good late rally. CRAVIN CADEN reserved until the quarter pole, had a good finish along the outside. SCARY GOOD worked his way to the lead, showed the way towards the inside, before weakening during the final furlong. EL PRIMERO saved ground to no avail. ON VACATION was through after going three-quarters. GRAVITAS failed to reach a contending position. HIGHVELDT STORM a forward factor racing in the three path, gave way after going six furlongs. VOLITION was outrun.
