EMMA'S POSSE was maneuvered over to the inside down the backstretch, gained the good fortune off a clear inside passageway into the lane, when DUBAI RAINBOW came off the rail at the three-eighths pole, gradually moved up, still well in hand, sped into contention, scooting by rivals who had chosen a wider route into the lane, squeezed by without much room to spare, still hugging the rail, in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole en route to the lead, poked a head in front at the eighth pole and edged away under good handling. MITIGATION unhurried for nearly a half, was placed four wide at the three-eighths pole, came home with good energy down the center of the strip to grab second. POPPA'S PICK patiently stalked the pacesetter from the three path under a good hold, gradually advanced forward after entering the turn, issued his bid for the lead at the three-sixteenths pole, loomed a serious threat with an eighth to go, but soon flattened out. THREE DAY RUSH raced along the outside and rallied mildly. DUBAI RAINBOW rode the rail during the early stages, was taken outward coming to the three-eighths pole, steadied off heels near the three-sixteenths pole, was immediately called upon but came up empty. MULTITUDE the last to come out of the gate, rushed up into the lead under his own courage, set the pace from the two path, rated and lightly pressed, was put to the test turning for home, offered brief resistance before succumbing. EZZY broke outward, chased three wide and folded.
