COUSIN STEPHEN away in good order, assumed a forward position, raced three wide around each bend, patiently stalked the front runners until the end of the backstretch, picked up interest and latched on to them midway on the turn and remained so until upper stretch, got set down as the widest of three spinning into the stretch on nearly terms with each other, needed only an additional sixteenth to grab control for good, lengthened away, kept to some encouragement to the end. GREAT MINDS prompted REBRANDED from the two path while placed to a firm hold by the pilot, had the winner increase his presence shortly after departing the backstretch, vied for command from between opponents from that juncture until near the three-sixteenths marker, fell far back, but held on well enough to secure second. STREET GENT raced towards the inside until approaching the quarter pole, had a wall comprised of three rivals a short distance up ahead, got angled outward four wide to gain optimal clearance in preparation for the drive home, drifted out a couple of more paths shortly afterwards, mustered up a mild response that wasn't good enough for place honors. REBRANDED out broke the field and maintained the advantage, cut the pace from the inside, lightly hand urged, was forced to argue with a pair parked to the outside coming to three-eighths pole, kept at the task until about halfway through the furlong grounds and gave way. RARE EAGLE swung three wide into the backstretch and was outrun. BEHEDEMAN three wide heading for the opening bend, travelled closer to the rail for most of the way around it, took the inside route down the backstretch, got eased back into the two path leaving the half mile pole, made no impact.
