TEN CARATS broke running, pressed the pace from the outside while in hand, took over and drew clear when set down turning for home and widened under a vigorous hand ride. VICARIOUS SARA, hustled along early, finished gamely on the rail to earn the place spot. RUM PUNCH showed good speed along the inside while in hand, attempted to move through along the rail approaching the stretch but was steadied, dropped back and weakened in the stretch. ROARING TWENTIES was hustled from the gate, raced wide and finished with good courage from the outside. SHE'S SO UNUSUAL set the pace under pressure from the winner and gave way in upper stretch. JAYHAWK JUDY raced greenly along the inside. XYLOPHONE came wide for the drive but had no response. GLITTER BOND chased outside and tired.
