FOR FILLIES and MARES THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD WHICH HAVE NOT WON A OPEN SWEEPSTAKES ON THE TURF. No nomination fee. A supplemental nomination fee of \$200 may be made at time of entry. \$500 to enter, starters to receive a \$250 rebate. The added money and all fees to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. Three year olds 122 lbs. Older 124 lbs. Non-winners 36,000 allowed 2lbs. Four races, 4 lbs. Three races 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, starter and restricted races not considered in allowances). A presentation will be made to the winning owner. Closed Thursday, November 3, 2005 with 27 Nominations. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at One Mile on the main track.). 

JOYFUL CHAOS was rated along inside, saved ground, found room on the rail in upper stretch, dug in gamely and prevailed, driving. LA REINA raced in hand early, advanced inside on the second turn, split rivals in the stretch and finished gamely. LADY BI BI was outrun early, rallied wide on the second turn, was steadied in the stretch and weakened. HONEY'S SKY pressed the pace from the outside, came out in the stretch and tired. ON THE BUS raced close up outside while in hand, rallied three wide, was steadied in upper stretch, was taken up sharply nearing the eighth pole and tired. SECRET FOREST set the pace along the inside and tired in the final furlong. PROVINCIAL raced inside and had no rally.
