SAILOR'S CAP raced with the pace while in hand, responded when roused in upper stretch and drew away under a drive. AQAB raced in hand along the inside, saved ground, angled out in the stretch and finished well. RUBAIYAT was steadied after the start, raced inside and finished well. SLAMBINO was outrun early, came wide into the stretch and had no rally. CARAVEL raced four wide on both turns and had no rally. BEL VIAGGIO leapt in the air at the start, was hustled to the front, set the pace for three quarters and tired. HYRULE raced three wide on both turns and tired. POMATINI broke slowly and had no rally. HE STRUCK IT RICH chased the pace while three wide and tired. G WILLIKERS was pulled up and walked off.
