WHIRLING AGATHA unhurried while well off the inside, was swung five wide into the lane, quickly settled into her rally after being straightened, sped past the leader leaving the furlong marker and drew off under an active drive. INDY'S FORUM engaged in a pace fight soon after leaving the starting gate, ducked inward nearing the turn, causing CHAUETTE to check in the process, zipped along unchallenged until midstretch, proved powerless to turn back the top one's strong bid for command, but continued on well to be a clear second. EIGHTYFIVE S reserved while wide, was fanned four wide into the stretch, lacked the necessary stretch response. GOODGOLLYMISSDOLLY outfinished weak rivals during the stretch drive. ITOBE chased the pacesetter during the run around the bend, backed off after entering the stretch. CHERNOBYL PRINCESS steadily tired after going a half. CHAUETTE involved in an early pace skirmish, was forced to steady when his fellow battler angled inward nearing the turn, continued to take the inside route, was forced to steady again when she appeared to have trouble handling the footing on the turn, gave way readily after turning for home.
