Footnotes

AMERICANUS was eased off the inside during the run around the bend, settled into his rally after turning for home, collared the leader approaching the sixteenth pole and edged clear. GOLD SHAMROCK, broke open the gate prior to the start, set the pace off the inside, was outfinished during the final sixteenth. LIGHTS OF BROADWAY raced three wide and held well. INTIMIDATING raced along the outside and lacked the needed bid. END OF AN ERA took the inside route, rallied into contention while continuing to save ground, flattened out during the final eighth. THE VIN MAN between rivals, had no rally. MUCHO GUSTO broke slowly, was taken to the far outside turning for home, offered no closing kick. ALRIGHT NOW underwent a four wide journey and gave way.
