SEE MORE SPIRIT unhurried while racing along the outside, was fanned five wide into lane, and was along in time under good handling. STOPBLUFFING saved ground, rallied willingly to take the lead midstretch, was outfinished by the top one leaving the sixteenth pole. ROGUE AGENT underwent a four wide journey and held well. OVEREXTENDED outfinished weak rivals. DEFREREOFTHEHEART raced four wide and tired. EXPRESS TO THEWEST was no factor. WILL NEVER BEND was outrun. DUKE OF DE BUQE set the pace well off the inside, faded after going three-quarters.
