SEAN AVERY pressed the early pacesetter from the outside under a good hold, moved to take over when ready during the run around the bend, extended his advantage when asked for a response in upper stretch, then maintained a safe margin to the wire. VENTANA was taken out to the four path upon reaching the turn, began to edge closer to the leader after being asked for a response at the midway point, continued on willingly during the stretch run to be along for the place while never threatening the top one at any point. ALMA D'ORO raced three wide and was outfinished for second. THE TRUFFLE MAN failed to gain ground appreciably down the lane, despite receiving strong encouragement. GREAT EMPEROR was no menace. GULF CAT off to an alert start, showed the way for three furlongs while racing towards the inside, offered no resistance when confronted by the top one, and steadily tired thereafter.
