Footnotes

MISS ATOMIC BOMB (GB) bobbed after rubbing shoulders with FRESH FELINE right after the start, was guided over to the rail well before reaching the end of the homestretch, vacated it in time for the start of the run around the second bend, spun five wide into the lane, took charge in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole and shook free. FRESH FELINE saved ground for the majority of the initial three-quarters, slipped into the two path at the head of the stretch, was unable to launch a rally in earnest, stuck behind a wall of rivals, altered course towards back to inside after seeing a sliver of hope down along the rail corridor near the beginning of the gap where the chute meets the main course, but to no avail, managed to angle outward with about a sixteenth pole, responded eagerly when given its cue and rallied to take the place. SUMBA SUNSET tracked the pace from the pocket, was put to urging to the outside entering the stretch, got outfinished late. MORNING STAR quickly to the lead and to rail, was rated along cutting the pace to the quarter pole, got let out after coming under heavy pressure at that stage, yielded with about a sixteenth to go and weakened. HOPE CROSS (IRE) forwardly placed three wide on both turns, lacked the needed late response. SKY PAINTER reserved in two path in the early going, unleashed a four wide run after departing the backstretch, failed to sustain it. UBIQUITOUS MANTLE (IRE) attended the pacesetter from the two path for nearly three-quarters before backing away. RUN OF THE RIVER off two beats slower than any other after breaking in a slightly awkward manner, raced four wide on the clubhouse bend, was one path closer on the next one, gave way. CHRYSOLITE strung out three wide on the turn, continued from off the inside, never made it into a contending position.
