DECADENT DESIGNER was unhurried outside early on, surged to the front with a three wide spurt midway on the turn, scampered clear in upper stretch and remained clear to the wire, driving. DEPUTY'S DELIGHT raced with the pace and continued on gamely through the stretch. DANCING WITH FIRE came wide approaching the stretch and had no rally. COMEDY OF ERRORS raced wide and had no rally. FLYING TASSIE showed speed along the inside and tired. HOPEAROO broke awkwardly and raced greenly. CHERRY FIZZ showed speed while three wide and tired after a half mile.
