Footnotes

JETER picked up speed approaching the end of the backstretch, out raced BE BULLISH and took over both the two path and the role of primary pursuer nearing the five-sixteenths pole, latched on fully to SAINT ARTUHR as the pair spun into the lane, forged his way to the front after a spirited tussle through the furlong grounds, cemented himself to the lead for good about a sixteenth later, dug in well enough to turn back the belated bid coming from the runner up. SPORTSWRITER rode the rail down the backstretch, had the rider take hold after coming up to a road block at the half mile pole, was allowed to ease back just enough to be taken off the inside route, accomplishing the goal around midpoint on the bend, got set down for the drive home, altered course several paths in upper stretch, kicked into his best stride soon afterwards, came home with good, but belated energy. LONGFOR THE CITY tipped into the three path at the five-sixteenths pole, closed in gradually proceeding down the stretch. MARSH DAWG shied inward slightly a couple of jumps after the start, got fanned into the six path coming to the three-sixteenths marker, cut into the gap but had to settle for the last major check. SAINT ARTHUR broke alertly and maintained control, was sent over to the rail before reaching the half mile pole, hooked up in an intense fight with the winner prior to the quarter pole and got fully roused, remained locked up in battle with the top one before getting shaken off at the sixteenth pole. BE BULLISH gave chase from the two path on the turn, was through after completing a half. CAY TO POMEROY bobbed at the start, faltered off the subsequent ground-saving journey.
